The food shelf provides pick-up services for companies that reach certain volumes and we qualified for the service. IntriCon and its employees collected **809 pounds** of food for the local food shelf. To put this in perspective, the average person eats approximately 5 pounds of food per day based on studies performed by the USDA.
