Basic Needs: The United Way stabilizes people in crisis with emergency food and safe shelter while giving them the job skills they need to increase their earnings for themselves and their families. Meeting basic needs is critical to helping our most vulnerable neighbors move up and out of poverty on their way to financial stability.

Education: The United Way focuses on three crucial stages in a child's education: early childhood, reading by third grade and quality out-of-school-time programming. Health: The United Way provides access to healthcare for underserved people, helps children and youth learn healthy behaviors that prevent future problems and provides support to thousands of older adults and people living with disabilities so they can remain independent.
