



Enterprise Network Manager

Duties and Responsibilities:

Take lead role in enterprise network design/architecture change planning, testing and implementation. Coordinate and manage change for enterprise hosted cloud infrastructure. Communicate cloud infrastructure intended use to plants. Manage O365 subscription licenses for the enterprise. Coordinate the reporting and resolution of enterprise network infrastructure problems to assure uninterrupted enterprise operations. Establish and maintain network user accounts, user environment, directories, security and user access rights for enterprise & Admin users. For cyber security plan: take lead role to define control descriptions & prioritize the implementation of needed controls, regularly review the threat landscape and revise the plan to meet actual threat protection needs and priorities; assure plant compliance to plan. Develop, implement and communicate policies & procedures that define enterprise information technology standards/guidelines. Policies/procedures to include, as appropriate, acquisition, configuration/setup, use, operation, security and administration for: infrastructure hardware, telecommunications, software systems, connectivity, user personal computers, printers, mobile devices, networked shop floor workstations, user accounts, data backup and data restore capabilities. For plant network systems, communicate need for and audit compliance with enterprise policies/procedures or approved plant-specific comparable policies/procedures. Define enterprise security awareness policies and procedures and monitor/audit plant compliance. Coordinate the analysis of traffic and performance data for enterprise network systems and recommend and/or coordinate changes to address security or performance issues. Consult with executives and management to develop enterprise system solutions consistent with organizational objectives. Develop, implement, communicate and test enterprise system disaster recovery procedures. Manage enterprise managed services provider performance to assure needs are met and performance matches MSP agreement details. Formally approve of changes to plant network systems as appropriate. Research, evaluate, prioritize, test, and coordinate the deployment of new technologies. Negotiate enterprise information technology supplier contracts as needed. Manage monthly enterprise IT expenses and provide input for annual enterprise IT expense budgeting/planning. Provide input for enterprise IT capital equipment annual budgeting/planning. Work may be required during off-peak hours.

Qualifications:

Bachelor's degree in Computer Science or related field required; 3-5 years hands-on Windows network design, implementation and support; 5-10 years' experience in a management or administrator role for Windows networks, Windows Servers, Active Directory, Windows Administration, Network Security. Over 3 years of hands-on experience with AD and GPO's highly valued. Minimum 5 years information security work experience required. 3-5 years of experience in a supervisory role preferred. Experience in a hosted cloud infrastructure required and experience using managed services preferred. Work experience with business process improvements and familiarity with change management



methodologies required. Experience defining & implementing IT policies, procedures and best practices. Prior experience managing and maintaining IT systems in regulated industries highly valued.
